Wirrimanu Aboriginal Corporation exists to service and benefit the Traditional Custodians of the Balgo community, the Tjurabalan People, and the Kukatja, Walmajarri, Jaru, Pintupi & Warlpiri language groups within.

Requests to visit the Balgo community and to access Wirrimanu services, facilities and equipment are considered on a case-by-case basis. Visitor restrictions may be applied by community leadership, authority directives, seasonal air/road conditions and by the limited availability of Wirrimanu services, facilities, and equipment. Community leadership reserves the right to refuse visitor entry to Balgo.



Wirrimanu community engagement and staff services

Balgo open community meetings must be agreed to by Wirrimanu Aboriginal Corporation Directors, with advance notice required



Wirrimanu Aboriginal Corporation Directors, as the designated community leaders, are available with advance notice via CEO for consultations, workshops, directives, and proponent engagement affecting the Balgo community Wirrimanu AC staff may require payment for time in liaising with community for engagement services for proponent agency requests. \$200 up to 2hrs, per director, per day \$400 greater than 2hrs, per director, per day
